YOU CAN APPLY FOR :

16-19 DISCRETIONARY BURSARY

- Help with travel costs
- Help with course related costs (books or equipment)
- Free College Meals (In receipt of Income based benefit)

Criteria:

- * Must meet the residency & income criteria

16-19 VULNERABLE BURSARY

- Help with education costs
- May be able to get help with Free College Meals.

Criteria:

- * Must meet the residency & income criteria
- * Currently in local authority care or a recent care leaver
- * If you are 18 and in receipt of Universal Credit in your own name

19+ ADULT EDUCATION BURSARY

- Help with travel costs
- Help with course related costs (books or equipment)
- Free College Meals (In receipt of Income based benefit)
- 19-25 EHCP
- 19+ Continuer
- Help with childcare costs

Criteria:

- * Must meet the residency & income criteria

19+ ADVANCED LEARNER LOAN

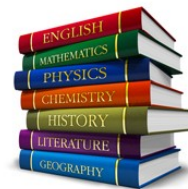
- In order to apply for a Student Bursary, you must be
 - 19 & in receipt of the Advanced Learner Loan & on a level 3, 4, 5 or 6 course
